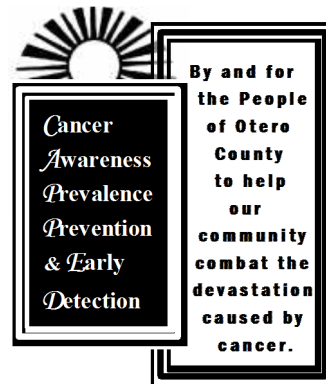

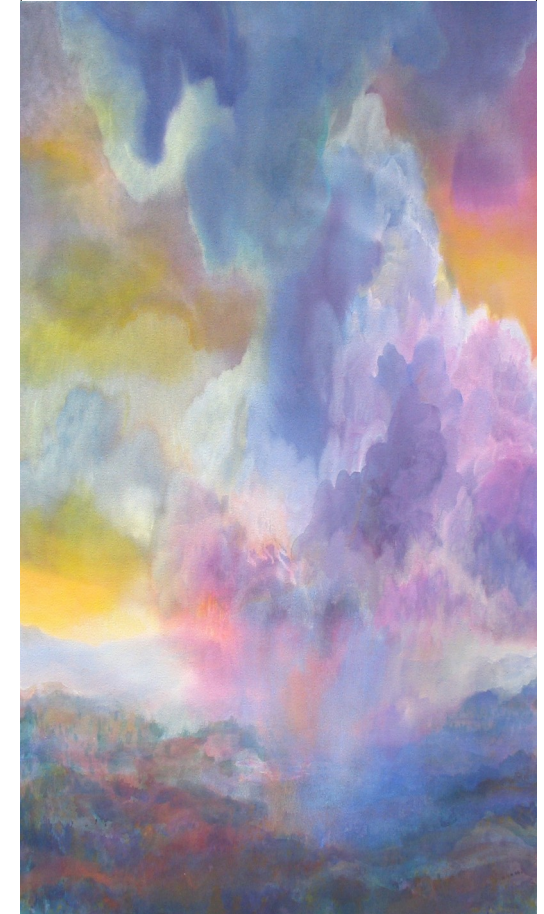

In 2004, the National Cancer Institute reported that 80-90% of cancers are caused by environmental factors. This was GREAT NEWS! This means 80-90% of cancers can be prevented if we implement healthier lifestyles and avoid unhealthy exposures.

CAPPED is helping accomplish this through their wonderful community outreach presentations. The CAPPED Sun Safe Program is

presented to children in grades K-4 throughout Otero County. CAPPED also presents cancer prevention and awareness programs to businesses, clubs, schools and civic organizations.

The CAPPED Building, located at 907 New York Ave., is open M-F, 10-5 to help you find the most current health information from the most reputable sites on the Internet. The CAPPED Building is staffed by a marvelous group of friendly, dedicated Volunteers. Books and videos are available for loan from the lending library. CAPPED provides free cancer information pamphlets published by the National Cancer Institute to anyone in need.

CAPPED helps the needy by providing free mammography screening for those who are uninsured or under-insured. CAPPED's Angel Fund provides limited resources to help uninsured individuals with the early diagnosis and treatment of minor cancers.

CAPPED's trained Volunteers and staff support cancer survivors through one-to-one walk-in support, providing free caps for those experiencing hair loss, Casen Therapy Dolls for any child experiencing multiple needle sticks, CAPPED Survivors Kits, Whole Foods nutrition classes as well as individual support and advocacy services.

CAPPED is also an official registration point for Angel Flights and the NM MedBank Program.

CAPPED writes grants to help support their programs and operations. Your support is vital because many grants are dependant upon support from the community being served.
